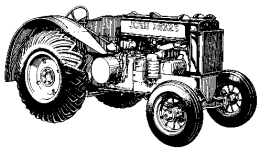

NW EXPO VII Better Than Ever!

The 2007 Northwest Two Cylinder EXPO VII beat the 2005 tractor exhibits with a total of 193 tractors including new generation models. The paying gate receipts exceeded 563 spectators. The number of vendor displays were down this year but were of high quality bringing Detwiler Tractor Parts from as far as Spencer, Wisconsin.

Dean VanPeurse, Albert Ulrich, Harvey Hamilton and APC magnetos presented high quality technical sessions relating to our two cylinder classics. Their technical sessions were as good as any presented at the Gathering of the Green and other national John Deere exhibitions and shows. In fact several of our local presenters do present at the national shows.

The featured tractor this year was the 1st John Deere Numbered Series organized by the Oregon Two Cylinder Club. The beautiful array of model 40, 50, 60, 70 and 80 John Deeres were featured. One of the high lights of the show was the display of over ten John Deere 320 models. Most national tractor shows will not have that many 320 models exhibited. Two classic Deeres traveling the furthest was a 1937 B owned by Steve Ebe (originally from Whatcom county) Palo Cedro, California and a 1937 BI owned by Arlan Adams from Redding, California.

Spectators traveling the greatest distance was a group of men from Tasmania sponsored by Albert Ulrich, Renaissance Tractor. There were also representatives

from Wisconsin, Idaho, California, Connecticut, North Carolina and our own member Richard Osborne from Alpine, Utah.

The Cascade Two Cylinder Club featured 13 tractors owned by Ben Oberg, Paul Hieb, Tom Jensen, Jon McCoy, Gary Friend, Alan Brinson, Alerd and Curtis Johnson, Norm tesselle, Brian DeLisa, Leon Meyers and Jim Sorensen.

The famous slow race was won this year by Gary Friend, 1st place; John Lemmon, 2nd place and Tom Jensen, 3rd place. What happened Paul? Paul Hieb deserved an award for bringing the most tractors from our club. Gary Tapio, Show Chairman; Carol Schwarz, Assistant Chair; Darlene Blair, Treasurer; and LaRayne Andrews, Secretary deserve a lot of credit for organizing a great show for our area! The internet seller offers a good deal tractor and wants the cash to be given to Western Union which in turn the seller wants the money transferred to a business called Money Bookers. The seller (scammer) claims that if the tractor is not acceptable when received that the money can be returned. Western Union warns on their web site that once Money Bookers gets the money then the seller can not cancel the transaction. Buyer beware! At that point you are at the mercy of the seller. There may have never been a tractor!

I personally have purchased quite a few tractor parts and books on eBay and using Paypal as the method of payment. So far no problems but buying sight unseen items can be disappointing. Usually eBay sellers do a good job of explaining the condition of the item

for fear of a bad rating on eBay. Please let us know if you have had any bad experiences with eBay or the internet in general.

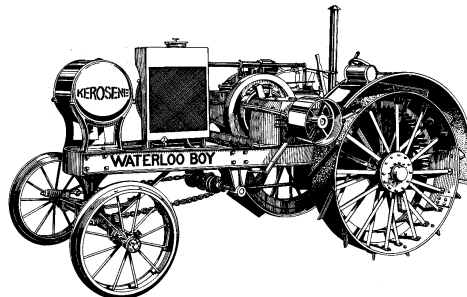

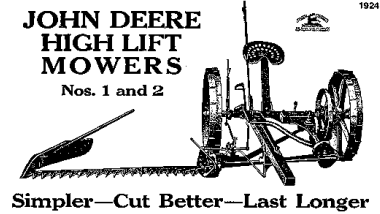

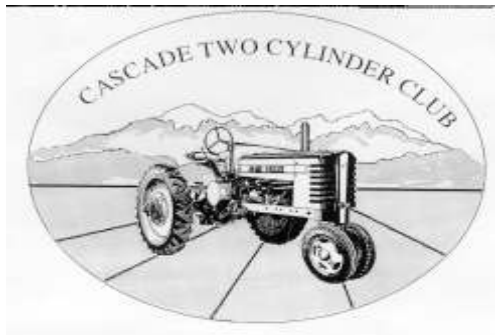
