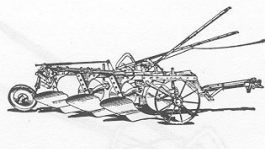

1947 John Deere Model “D”, Serial Number 166541

In 1946 my grandfather, Martin N. (Mart) Leque ordered his last JD Model D from Barnett Equipment in Mount Vernon, Washington. Research shows that JD Model D, Serial Number 166541 (“The D”) was shipped on September 25, 1946 through the Portland, Oregon branch house with a destination of Mount Vernon, Washington. (The tractor is special to me as I was born in November of 1946). For many years Mart used model D tractors on the 130 acre dairy and cropland farm which he farmed from 1911 to 1947. The farm had been homesteaded by my great grandfather, N. P. Leque in 1876 on land later to be named “Leque Island” located in the far Northwest corner of Snohomish County west of the Stillaguamish River across from Stanwood, Washington.

The D worked the cropland on Leque Island in 1947 and then powered an Oliver “Red River Special” threshing machine for Mart's custom threshing operation. At the end of 1947, after farming for 36 years on Leque Island, Mart retired and moved to another dairy and cropland family farm located on Livingston Bay

on Camano Island, Washington which had been purchased by his wife's father (my great-grandfather Hans Myron) in 1910. The D labored faithfully on the Camano Island farm from 1947 to the mid 1960's when the farm was leased to various crop farmers. The D was used occasionally on the farm until the D was sold in 1980 to a logger on Camano Island. In 2000 my brother, Jay and I decided to repurchase the D. We located it disassembled on Camano Island. We purchased it and returned it to our farm on a lowboy where my brother reassembled it and got it running again. We used the D on the farm for various duties and by 2011 it was looking “well used” after 64 years of faithful service. The tractor had its share of bumps and bruises. For example, in the mid 50's the D was operated too near the main drainage ditch on the farm and the D rolled over into the ditch submerging it until only the rear tires were visible above the water level. And in 1972 the D caught fire and was burned almost beyond recognition.

In 2011 the tractor was delivered to Eric Hanson in Silvana who beautifully removed the countless dents, fabricated replacement rusted or missing sheet metal parts, and then expertly repainted it in the classic John Deere green and yellow. Over the next 10 years the D was mechanically (Continued on page 3)

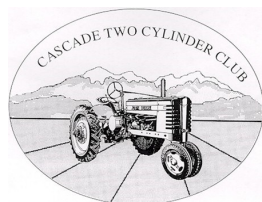

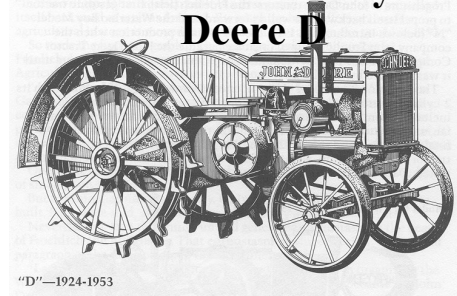

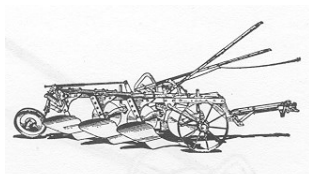

showing it age and running poorly. In January of 2021 I delivered the tractor to Washington Tractor (Pape) in Mount Vernon with instructions to “go through the engine and make it right.” I did not put a completion deadline on the project, but for the mechanic to work on it when they had some time. The mechanic (Mike Lang – President of Sky Valley Tractor Club) put many hours and expertly restored the engine. In July of 2022, after 19 months, the rebuild was finished literally from the oil pump upwards. The work done was extensive. It took six months to get a block from the east coast that would pass a magnaflux crack test. The block was bored and aluminum pistons installed, the governor was completely rebuilt, the flywheel replaced, exhaust and intake manifolds replaced, and so forth. The list of parts replaced is several pages long. But now the engine starts and runs perfectly.

Now the D is used occasionally on the farm, but mainly makes appearances in local parades pulling floats, is on display at the Stanwood Camano Community Fair and drives the threshing machine each day for the public's education and enjoyment, and proudly makes appearance under U.S. Flags on the front yard of the farm, which is adjacent to State Highway 532 where it is literally seen by thousands of people each day going to and from Camano Island.
