

31 Years of Green and Yellow tractor fun

Vic Jensen and his long love for Deeres

My Dad worked for Don Youngquist in Skagit County when I was in the 6,7,8 and 9th graders. During that time is when the green bug bit me and I learned how to drive a new JD 60 and JD 70 that Don had bought. My wife Judy and I started our own dairy in 1967 east of Sedro Wooley. Having a dairy farm means you need equipment to handle feed and waste. Our first tractor was a John Deere 60. Our second one was a John Deere 1020 with loader. On the Bayview Edison Road we bought our first farm in 1972. We traded the JD 60 on a used JD 3020 power shift diesel and a second one in 1978. In 1976 I bought the first 5" x 6' round baler and baled 700 bales of barley straw to use for open housing bedding for the cows. I needed a bigger loader so I put a wide front end under the first JD 3020 and a 158 loader on it. In 1978 we moved our farming operation to the Field Road. We farmed there for 31 years. The list of tractors kept growing. A 950 Yanmar JD scraper tractor, JD 2030 loader, JD 4230 hyd-front wheel assist loader, JD 4640 with cab and duals, a real work horse.

The last working tractor was a JD 7520 8 wheel articulated tractor from Oregon. My brother Tom Jensen who I give a lot of credit for helping us found this tractor in Oregon. It had 8 new tires and a broken crankshaft in the engine. We had it hauled up here and got an engine with 50 hours on an overhaul. Tom swapped engines and it dynoed over 200 h.p.

Other color tractors

During the farming years we did own 9 different size Massey Fergurson tractors, an IT 14G Cat loader and a Gehl skid steer loader.

I bought another JD 60 for show and sold it. Later I bought a JD 70 standard from Marlen Knutsen's collection. This tractor was fully restored and has been to club plow days pulling a 3-16 plow. I have driven the 70 from my home to and from Sedro Woolley Fourth of July parade and to the La Conner Caravans. A couple of years ago I drove the 70 with #12 one row corn chopper in the Burlington Berry Dairy Days parade. This tractor has been to the Lynden Vintage Farming Days show and also featured at the Lynden Fair antique tractor display. My son Doug and I bought a JD 40 standard a few years ago. Later I saw a loader tractor for sale along side a road which turned out to be the 1963 JD 2010 with loader that I drove and worked with on the Field Road dairy that we now owned. It was all original when we bought it and needed some deserved care. We put new tires on it and Tom and Doug fixed the transmission. My sons Dennis and Doug have picked up the love of green and Dennis now has a JD 80 and Doug a JD 3010. We really appreciate the Cascade Two Cylinder Club!



Keep Dec. 7 open for our Christmas Holiday Potluck dinner. See you at the dinner.


