

32 Years of Green and Yellow tractor fun

#### Local John Deere 730 d Revival

On September 14, 1959 John Deere shipped eight 730 model tractors to the Portland Oregon branch, all consecutive serial numbers 7319707 through 7319714.

The first tractor was shipped to Barnett Implement, Mount Vernon, Washington and sold February 11, 1960 to Dave Deyo of La Conner. He farmed it until Tom Jensen bought the tractor on November 20, 1992. I bought it from Tom on August 18, 1994. This John Deere 730 row crop is serial number 7319707 with a wide front, diesel engine with electric start. I farmed with it for eight years and then put it in the shed. This last spring I got it running but the engine had a lot of blow by so I tore the engine down and found a hole in one of the pistons. I looked and found a good used .045 inch over size piston. The cylinder wall was good so the engine was put back together.

So now on to restore the tractor. Parts taken off and repaired if needed then sandblasted and primed the sheet metal. The next step was to send the sheet metal to C2CC member Chris Hrutfiord's shop for painting. Generator, starter and cylinder head all gone through. Tires taken off and wheels sandblasted and are back from powder coating. Now I am looking for new tires. I

just primed the chassis and it is ready for some green paint.

I hope I can get it back together this summer for the parades, shows and the Pioneer Picnic in La Conner.




John Deere 730 diesel row crop tractor

## President's Message


I hope 2025 is a happy year for everyone. Our Christmas Holiday dinner was fun with lots of good food and time to visit.


