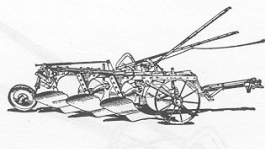

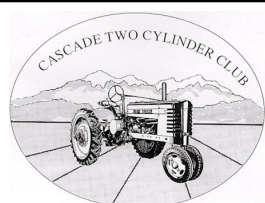

Did You Know?

The John Deere Museum at the Lynden Puget Sound Antique Tractor and Machinery Association show grounds has been open since 2008. This building was completed with C2CC donated money, supplies and labor. Paul Hieb, our President was the lead carpenter and did a wonderful job of constructing the building with member assistance.

When our club was formed in 1993 we were advised to have a rule to not own any antique equipment so technically the antiques displayed are on loan. We are trying to tag each antique with the name of the person loaning the item.

During a museum cleaning day several weeks ago I couldn't help thinking what a great collection of John Deere farm equipment we have gathered. Thanks to Fred Polinder we have an original John Deere dealership store counter and set of John Deere parts books from the two cylinder era. The counter came from a Montana dealership. On the wall behind is an original North Washington Implement sign loaned from Elaine Nyhoff. Out front is an original John Deere sign attached to a large standard. In the back room on a bench are various specialty tools used on the old two cylinder Deeres. Some of these came from North Washington Implement. Our thanks to retired North Washington Implement parts person Norm teSelle for the help. One of my favorite new old Deere

display parts is a drive chain for a John Deere D. Owning a John Deere D I can't imagine ever needing one so that's probably why it was a surplus new old part. In the front room are several antique gas cans, gas and oil pumps dating to the early 1900s. These were loaned from Marlen Knutsen and Loren Dahl.

Loren Dahl has probably loaned the most items to the museum. Loren specializes in early John Deere horse drawn implements including plows, harrows and a cultivator. He also displays a set of his miniature horse drawn wagons that he has hand crafted. Jim Hale has recently loaned an early 1900s John Deere wagon which is a very rare collectable. He has also loaned a John Deere spoked D tractor which is currently displayed at the Lynden Museum. Jim has been a big contributor of collectables and money to this museum project.

We also have two early John Deere horse mowers which were very common in the day. Bob Folk loaned a nicely restored 1940s horse drawn John Deere manure spreader that came from Skagit Valley. This Deere horse/tractor spreader was featured in The Green Magazine.

One of our latest treasures is Ken Langel's 1922 Waterloo Boy loaned from an unnamed source. Many more Deere antique implements from the Skagit, Whatcom and San Juan Island counties are on display. The implements give an idea of the equipment used in the last century when horses and tractors were on the farm.

5. Tom discussed the reason for signing up for the parade of Dairy Berry Days due on June 21.

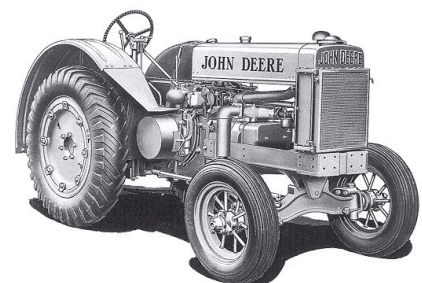
6. Discussed the reason why Shelly VanBeek wants to use our area for the kids treasure hunt during the fall Vintage Farm days in July-August get together.

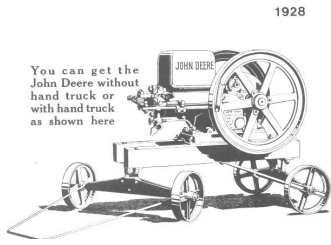
