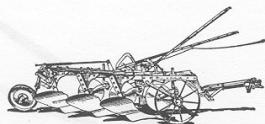

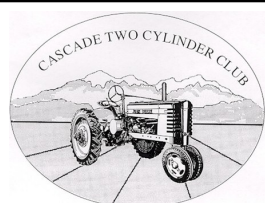

My John Deere story started a couple years ago, at the Lynden Steam and Tractor Show. We were only there for a few hours, but that's all it took. I was hooked. After that day I was on the hunt for my own tractor.

I talked to my friend Clint about it and a few weeks later he told me about his BO he had just picked up. There was another one for sale from the same collector down in Seattle. I got in touch with the guy and went down to pick it up.

It ran well and had new tires. It needed a little paint work, but all in all a solid little 1942 BO. I didn't know much about the tractor. I had never driven a hand clutch before and it seemed very foreign to me. I found it was easier than I anticipated to operate, and I loaded it up for the trip home.

At my first 2-cylinder meeting I was excited to talk to people about my tractor. When I did, they would say "only one?" I would answer yes, and they would reply "not for long." How right they were. Now me and my boys own seven, thanks to some very generous club members.

After attending that first meeting I knew that I had found something special.

We have had so much fun and made some great memories in the past two years. The tractor show has become the highlight of our summer and we camp out all week now.

My three boys and I spend lots of evenings in the shop working on our tractors and planning for the next parade or show.

A favorite memory is when we pulled an old hay wagon out of the brush from the Mcrae Farm only four days before the 4th of July parade. I had to mill the boards, have a tire repaired and we painted the entire thing just in time for the parade. The paint was still tacky.

I grew up with a 1939 Ford 9N that my dad and brother restored. I spent many hours working with that tractor, but have always loved watching the shiny green and yellow tractors in the parades every year.

I remember listening to my dad talk about Tom Jensen, who he worked with, and all the cool old John Deere tractors he had.

I'm so thankful for this club and all the great people we've met. This truly is the nicest group of people. Me and my family have been so blessed by the people within the club. I look forward to many more years talking and dreaming about tractors with the members of this club, who have become such good friends.

10. Tom brought up liability insurance costs for members of our club. Cost is \$673 at the present.

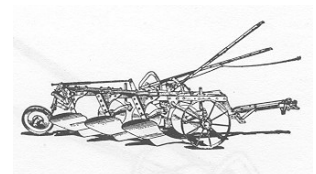
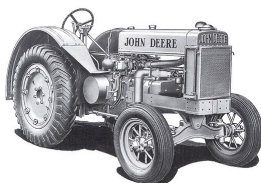
11. Insurance cost was also brought up for members when being involved in parades.

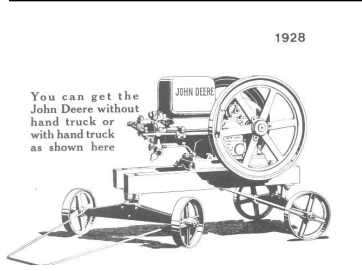
Jim Sorensen and JD 420 at the 2025 Burlington Veteran's Day Parade

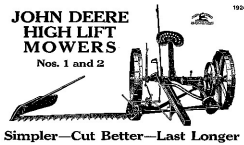
