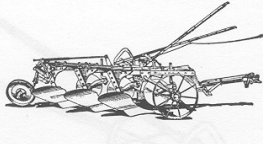

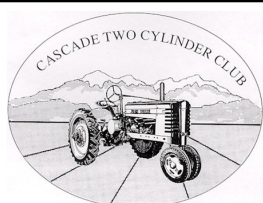

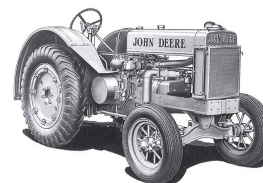

Please note! Club makes needed money off the raffle and silent auction items. If bringing silent auction items please indicate a minimum bid amount.

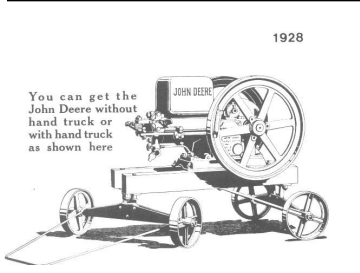
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President's Message

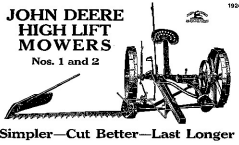
