



Steve Schuh, Skagit Farmer Since 1963

Like a lot of farmers what Steve farmed in 1963 is much different than what he does today. In Steve's youth, his dad worked for Puget Sound Energy but he wanted a farm life for his two sons. As a result Steve's brother became an ag teacher for Burlington High School and Steve became a farmer with his wife Susan.

Initially the Schuh farm was peas and seed crops for Christianson Seed Company. When the corporate pea industry was leaving the area in the late 1970s the Schuh Farm started moving into retail food. With Susan's prompting, 3 acres of U-Pick strawberries were tried and were quite successful. Next were marion berries, tayberries, loganberries and boysenberries. In the 1980's raspberries were added but required help picking with the produce being sold at all the local farmer's markets. Sweet corn was added to the farm as well as pumpkins, squash, blue berries and cucumbers. Produce is sold all over Western Washington. They travel to farms in Eastern Washington to purchase produce such as cherries, apricots, peaches, nectarines and melons. Steve farms 300 acres.

Deeres

On one of the road trips, Steve spied a John Deere M that was for sale. The tractor was being sold by the local Bakersfield High School Ag class. Steve was mildly interested but Susan decided Steve should buy the Deere. The tractor was loaded on their truck with a crane and the tractor is still in Steve's procession. Steve says that the

John Deere M is too slow for the caravans. Another 2 cylinder acquired is the 1953 John Deere G from North Carolina. This tractor draws the most attention with the 48" front end and ice cream maker attached to the rear. Yes, the ice cream maker does work. The 48" front end was a factory option. The engine has been bored out and we all know G's have power. Steve is not a puller but likes the parades and tractor shows and of course the caravans. He wishes we could caravan back to Lopez Island but he knows that may not happen. He has a good customer there. Another 2 cylinder owned was a JD 630 used for irrigating. Moving into the newer and "big boy" Deeres are a 3020, 4430 and a 4555.




Steve's 1953 Late Styled John Deere G with special front end
