

29 Years of Green

Dan Lefeber, Skagit County Deere Collector

Dan has recently started collecting Deeres in 2019 but has been around tractors his whole life. He was told that he helped steer tractors when he was 5 years old, driving the tractor at 6, operating a field cultivator when he was 8 and digging bulbs when he was 12. Dan grew up in a Skagit Valley bulb family that grew daffodils, tulips and iris and of course there were the rotational crops of grain and peas. Dan knows tractors and field work. In the early years Dan's Dad bought and traded his tractors at Barnett's Equipment which included two Ms, MT, MC, B, 60 and a 730. All two cylinder tractors. Tractors were traded up as new and better Deere models were available.

Dan worked farming but spent much of his career fire fighting and working for Dike 12 a commissioner and now as operations manager. In the last three years Dan has quickly secured some nice classics from the Skagit Valley area. Most from members in our C2CC club. Dan doesn't restore tractors so he tries to get models already restored or in good original condition. His Deere stall currently includes a 1938 D, 1945 G, 1947 AR, 1952 B, 1953 60 and a 1954 70. The G and B are fully restored. Pretty good for three years of collecting. Yes, there is a Farmall H. I think he had to take it to get a certain Deere, the 60 which was his dad's. His rarest is the 1938 D and his favorite is the 1953 60. That takes him back to his younger years on the farm.

His favorite feature of collecting is displaying and the two cylinder sound and of course the fellowship of the club members.

President's Message




