

John put in 25 years working at Mount Baker Plywood and then left to work for Birch Equipment as a mechanic. After 18 years with Birch Equipment, John retired to have fun and restore Deeres at his 2 acre mini farm on the Ten Mile Road, Lynden. John and his wife Loretta have lived there for 43 years. Tractor restoration keeps John really busy but he takes time in the summer to vacation at a family cabin on Waldron Island and a lot on Lopez Island.

John had a solid background in mechanics so the mechanical part of bringing the Deeres back to top condition was not too difficult. John has learned the “tin” work and painting and enjoys the whole restoration experience.



The current restored Deere herd includes a 1936 AO, 1948 A, 1948 B; 1947 G 1948 M with factory loader and a JD 70 diesel row crop. The 70d was restored in May just in time for the Lynden show in August. A 1939 John

Deere B is not yet restored. John helped his son Jeff restore the JD 60 and the JD L is scheduled to be restored in the near future. Most of the tractors are from the local area with the exception of the AO and 1948 A.

John tries to make the hobby a family affair involving his wife Loretta and their two sons and families. The PSAT&MA show is a great time for the Grahams to get together and drive the beautiful Deeres in the parade. It helps for John to treat the family to lunch! When asked what part of collecting does he like best, John say that he likes it all and especially looking for parts. It’s kind of like a puzzle to be solved. John has shown his tractors at the Washington Tractor– Lynden (aka North Washington Implement)John Deere Day, summer P.S.A.T.&M.A. Lynden show and the Bellwood Acres Farm Market and Bis-tro.

The Green Magazine and the Two Cylinder magazine have many sources of services but are mostly located in the mid west. Members would like to save money on shipping and give business to the local shops.

The Club can not endorse any of these service providers and we realize that we have not included all the businesses or individuals that can do the work. We hope that you can help us add to this list additional local sources that you have had experience.

The following is a list of restoration service categories that we have included:

- Professional painting and sheet metal repair
- Sand blasting, powder coating and media blasting
- Brake lining/clutch lining repair
- Electrical systems repair and overhaul (starters & generators)
- Magneto and distributor repair
- Antique tractor tires
- Radiator/fuel tank repair
- Machine work(valve guide installation, valve grind-

ing, head resurfacing, crack detection, boring, sleeving etc.)

-Tractor Repair (engine, transmission and related items)

-Hydraulic systems (repair and parts)


-Diesel Services



