27 Years of Green and Yellow tractor fun

Loren Dahl, Horse Implement Collector and More

Loren has been the force behind the John Deere horse implements displayed at the Berthusen Park John Deere building. Loren has his John Deere tractors but he has encouraged club members to display the really old Deere implements designed to be pulled by real horse power. Currently, Loren has a harrow cart, single row corn planter, single row cultivator and plow hiller on display.

This past winter Loren elected the help from Paul Hieb and Ray Riggles to recreate a 1876 Scotch harrow from an image in a John Deere catalog. Loren says this was the year before Charles Deere (John Deere's son) merged with Elvah Mansur. Mansur was famous for his quality planting implements. Paul did the wood work and Ray did the machine work. Loren found the materials. This harrow will be on display at the Lynden show this August 5 - 8. Other horse drawn implements displayed: a sulky plow and two row cultivator donated by Bob Calhoun, a walking plow donated by Gary Worline and a potato hiller owned by Bob Folks. Bob also displays the 1940s restored John Deere Manure spreader. Besides horse implements, Loren has created many toy farm wagons and buggies. He originally purchased a set of four small cast wagon wheels from a source in Oregon. Needing more wagon wheels he had a foundry in Tacoma cast more wheels. From photographs, he constructed a small rural mail buggy, John Deere horse drawn wagon and numerous other farm wagons. Loren says he has never sold any wagons but gives them away to friends and relatives. You can see some of these on display at the John Deere museum.

Horses- Loren grew up on a Skagit Valley dairy farm near where he lives today. His

father farmed with horses up through the 1940s before an Allis Chalmers was purchased. Loren remembers a Percheron and Clydesdales doing the field work. The horse implements included rakes, plows, mower and a tedder. Besides haying for the livestock, Loren's dad grew seed oats, spinach, cabbage and turnips. Loren farmed with his dad from 1956 to 1959. In 1959 Loren and Joan married and Loren took over the farm.

Loren always loved horse and learned from his brother in law, Jerry Peth how to ride horses and do rodeo competition. As a sophomore in High School Loren won the 1954 Skagit Valley Rodeo champion trophy. He rode a white faced rodeo cow. He still has the trophy cup to prove it. Loren knew how to ride brahma bulls and bull dog. Cowboy Loren was also involved in three mile cattle drives with his brother in law. In the early years, Loren teamed up with Charlie Waters and Morrie Robinson to form the Early Day Gas Engine and Tractor Association Branch 26 club. Loren is also a charter member of the Cascade Two Cylinder Club and has been an officer and board member since the beginning. During his working days, Loren always took his vacation time during the PSAT&MA show. Loren currently owns a John Deere 520, wide front A, BR, and two 110 lawn mowers.
