Due to the volume of exhibitors please unload and move your truck and trailer as soon as possible and park in the free show parking area west of Berthusen's Park. A shuttle will transport you to the show grounds. Berthusens Park RV camping is available next to the show grounds but fills up quickly. Most members dry camp in the private Mayberry field east of the show grounds.

On Tuesday, August 1, Washington Tractor will sponsor a potluck dinner at the PSAT&MA show grounds for all retired and current Washington Tractor employees, PSAT&MA and C2CC exhibitors. The potluck will be in the food court starting at 5:30.
