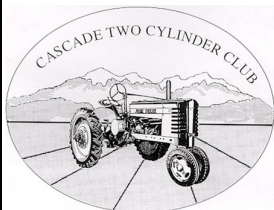

## Big Yakima Two Cylinder John Deere Tractor Auction

March 23 was a big day for two cylinder Deere lovers in Yakima Washington. Chuck Yarbrow Auctioneers was hired by Ken Winters to auction his extensive collection of 20 series and 30 series John Deere two cylinder tractors.

39 tractors were sold in three uninterrupted hours. In addition to the 20 and 30 series tractors a GN, G, H, A and MC were also sold.

The top dollar tractors included a nice JD 330 Standard at \$13,000, a JD 430c crawler with blade and 3 point hitch, \$11,250 and a JD 430t multi fuel, \$16,500.

Since this auction was also an internet auction some of the tractors were sold to out of state buyers and possibly bumped up the prices. The general feeling was the prices were average for the west coast. Greg Greenfield was top bidder on a 1958 520 LP tricycle and Phil Smooth took home a 1957 320s and a 1970 110 patio lawn tractor. We will expect to see those at the May Gas Up at the Skagit Valley Fair Grounds. Other club members attending were Paul Hieb, Ray Riggles, Vic and Tom Jensen, and Jim Alvashere. They left their wallets in their pockets.

Ken Winter is a retired farmer who restored some of the tractors and bought some out of other collections. One of his friends indicated that Ken may start another collection soon.

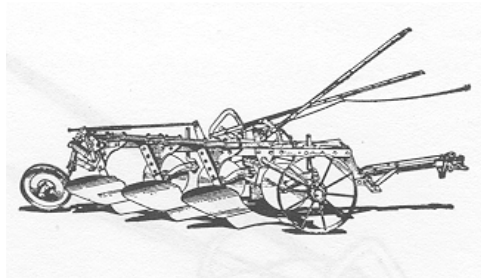
**Local tractor shows** included the **16th Mid-Winter Skagit Gas Up** at the Cascade Mall, February 13. February 8-12 Inside Mall display.

### Another method to remove twisted off bolts, cap screws, drill bits and taps

In the March 2019 edition of the Green Magazine, contributing writer Dan Brotzman writes about a product called X-Tractalloy. He says that you can find this product on eBay, Amazon and welding supply stores. It's a welding rod that forms a ceramic coating around the welding arc to protect the existing threads. In quick summary, you weld up the hole created by the broken bolt, weld on a washer and then a nut that you will use to extract the broken bolt. Simple as that! Right! I have left lots of steps out but you need to read the article or watch the instructional video on YouTube. This method is supposed to work for broken taps and drill bits too. Dan Brotzman say it works. What's your experience?

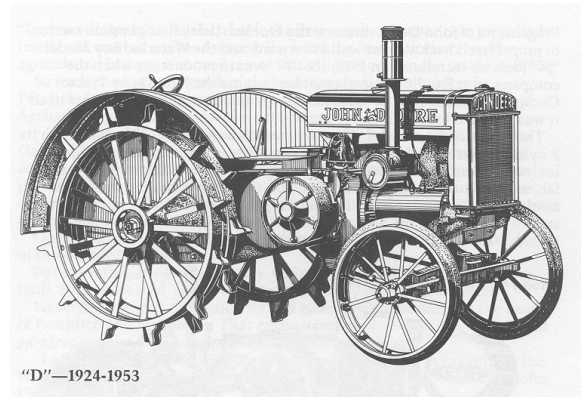
