John Deere 620 Hydraulic Problem

One of the advantages of belonging to a club is that you can commiserate with members about problems. If you get enough people trying to solve a problem the odds are someone will have the answer. So goes the dilemma with Paul Hieb's John Deere 620. The tractor lost hydraulics which of course operates the 3 point hitch and remote cylinder. Paul removed the pump and checked the tolerances which were satisfactory. His next step was to take the pump to Northwest Hydraulics in Lynden. They also deemed the pump good but were unable to run the pump for lack of gear drive to do a test run. Step 3 was to call in the pros, Con Holleman and John Maas to take a "run" at the problem. They used air pressure forcing oil into the pump. The pump worked a little. Con and John concluded that the problem must be in the pump. Paul's next step was to order a replacement pump from New Paris Equipment. The new used pump was installed on the tractor and it worked! Not to quit without an answer, Paul took the old pump apart and found two seals torn. With further inspection Paul found the bushing on the pump shaft had moved slightly destroying the seal. Paul pushed the bushing back into place and put in new seals and it worked. John Maas remarked that in his time working on this type of tractor he had never seen this happen except for a key breaking. The moral to the story

is that more heads are better than one. A Johnson

John Deere 420c Restoration Progress by Steve Ebe

I don't have much to add regarding the 420C that is currently under restoration. We haven't dedicated much time to the restoration effort lately. I may have told you that I was able to purchase a complete 420 air cleaner canister that was in very good condition from New Paris Tractor Parts. I saw a video posting on Facebook by New Paris Tractor Parts of a 420 wheel tractor they had just got in and quickly put in my request for the air cleaner canister. I was also able to purchase a hydraulic oil reservoir that is in pretty good condition with a few minor dents in the bottom that will not be visible. I put word out on the Two-Cylinder Club of Facebook about needing a reservoir and a fellow named Ted with R. S. Dier & Sons in Ontario, Canada responded. The business card says they are specialists in used John Deere parts since 1971. He sent me a very complete series of photos showing the condition of the reservoir. I was a bit apprehensive about the shipping but he said it would not be a problem. He quoted me a price which was in Canadian dollars. He did say there was a possibility that I would be charged a duty fee upon delivery. With the current favorable exchange rate, I felt the price was fine in US dollars since I was not having good luck finding a reservoir anywhere at all. 
Treasurer's Report- Tom Jensen






Happy Great Grandfather!

Steiner Tractor Repair Videos www.steinertractor.com

Most of us have used Steiner for parts for our tractors but did you know that they sponsor Steinertractor.tv.com? Tyler Buchheit, who writes for the Green Magazine and sells hard to find plow parts, makes John Deere repair videos and posts on the Steinertractpr.tv.com. I have found that the site works better with Goggle Chrome. Some of Tyler's John Deere videos are as follows:

- -Throttle speed control repair and adjustment
- -JD D fuel system
- -Brake rebuild on JD A
- -Steering repair on John Deere
- -Electronic ignition install
- -Radiator core replacement
- -New Generation seat suspension rebuild
- -Tach drive gear install
- -Power steering pump rebuild

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Also, I was not charged any duty fee upon delivery. He did a great job packing it and the reservoir was just as he described. I would not hesitate to contact them again about finding used parts.

The 420C with loader that I bought in December has a 3-point hitch but did not have the toplink. The fellow I purchased the crawler from saw an online ad in Yesterday's Tractor for a 420C/430C top-link. He contacted Dax who then contacted me. As you know 3-point top-links for the crawler tractors are not the same as for that model of wheel tractor. Also, since a 3-point hitch was an option for the crawler tractors, it makes them pretty rare. Top-links easily got separated from the tractors over the years. So when one is advertised, it is definitely worth checking out. I contacted the seller and he still had it available so I was able to get it. It has factory primer paint on it, looks like it is NOS, and never been on a tractor. I am quite happy about finding one the condition it is in. The one item missing was the pin to attach the top-link to the tractor. I inquired at the local John Deere dealer (I looked up the part number online) and was told that the part is obsolete and they did not show any in inventory anywhere within the John Deere system. I was able to find a drawbar pin at Tractor Supply that is the correct diameter (1-inch) and adequate length (at least 5-1/2 inches long to fit the attachment bosses on the tractor). It will work until I might come across the correct John Deere OEM pin. See below photo.

New Business: There will be no shop tour this year/


Plow Day: Phil is working to get some ground but nothing definite yet.
