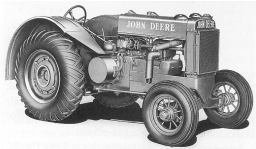

## Oscar- Farming, John Deeres, the Steam Trac- tor & Threshing

### Farm History

Oscar Lagerlund grew up on a Skagit Valley farm, drove horses when he was 9 years old and started plowing when he was 12 years old. He remembers plowing with a John Deere BW and McCormick Deering plow that was “sprung”. His dad had a disabling injury and had to sell the herd in 1946 but kept two heifers from a 24 milking cow herd. Oscar started building a herd and had five cows that were hand milked. After high school he attending junior college and managed a herd of 20 cows milked with a Surge milking machine. His dad told him to either sell the cows or drop out of college. Oscar dropped out of college and became a full time dairy farmer. In 1962 Oscar bought out his dad and was married to Joyce. He built the herd up to 60 cows and farmed up to 1000 acres of Skagit Valley farm land. In 1966 he got involved in the Farm Management Program and in 1996 Oscar formed Lagerlund and Son Inc. with his son Nels running the farm. They currently milk 350 to 400 cows on 500 acres with another 500 acres in pasture and forest land.

### Tractors

Oscar started out with a Barnett Implement John Deere BW which he wished he still owned. He moved to a JD 60 and a JD 70 diesel tricycle. He traded the John Deere 70d for a 1964 John Deere 4020. Oscar briefly used a 1958

Ford 641diesel Select a speed which he traded for a John Deere 2020. He has taking ownership of a John Deere A owned by his uncle and a very clean 1959 John Deere 630 found on Samish Island. A JD 2020, 2550, and 3150 have been in the Lagerlund herd but have moved on. Other modern Deeres he and Nels currently own are a 4020, 4440 with rototiller, 2150, 2640, 5220, 7410, 7430, 7810, and 7800 feeder wagon. He currently has 11 Deeres which all run except for the John Deere A.

### Case Steam Tractor

The 1914 Case Steamer was owned by John Ball who had purchased it from a saw mill operator in Whatcom county. The Steam tractor was used in Skagit county to operate a 1920s Oliver Red River Special threshing machine. In its later years the tractor was run on compressed air from a engine compressor unit that was towed behind the tractor. The Ball farm was located in the Skagit flats near the Farm House Restaurant and was famous for the distinctive two story old farm house. John Ball died in 1970's and the Case tractor remained in a barn until 1990. Oscar bought the tractor at the estate auction with some competitive bidding from out of state buyers. Successful in the bid, Oscar decided he needed the tractor to run something so he bought at the same auction the Oliver Red River Special threshing machine. The Steamer needed some help so Nels got guidance from Frank Orr and Jim Taft for en-

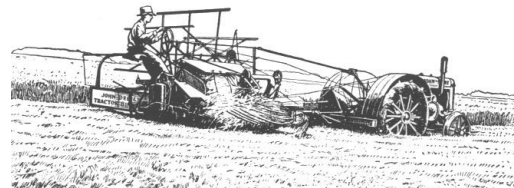

gine/boiler repair and proper operation. 2003 was the "rebirth" of the Case and Nels and Oscar proudly ran the tractor through the Burlington Berry Dairy Days parade. The tractor has been in the parade for 11 years. Due to the size of the Case, Farmers Equipment has graciously hauled the tractor to parades and the Lynden PSAT&MA show.

**Bellville Threshing Show**

In 2003 Oscar and Nels planted four acres of grain to be harvested the old fashion way with a binder, shocks and threshed with the steam Case and Oliver Red River Special threshing machine. Nels had found a binder but needed much work before operation. A hot tip lead to a Whatcom county collector who had a later model John Deere pto binder that was ready to work. This binder was donated to the "cause" and Bellville Threshing 2003 show was ready to go! Fortunately there have been enough "old timers" to teach the "young timers" how to bind grain, shock bundles, loading wagons, feed the thresher, sack grain and operate Jerry Senner's stationery baler. Each year members from the Cascade Two Cylinder Club and others have been "giving a hand" to Oscar and Nels. This annual event scheduled for the third Saturday in August has become a draw for antique tractors, cars, trucks and threshing equipment. The tractor turns 100 years old this year and Oscar 80 so this should be a special year at the August 16, 2014 Threshing show. Come out and celebrate the historic birthday.

It's also important to note that Oscar and Joyce Lagerlund have been selected as Skagit County Pioneer family of the year. We owe Oscar, Joyce and Nels a lot for continuing this historic farm activity. A big tip of the green and yellow hat to the Lagerlunds!

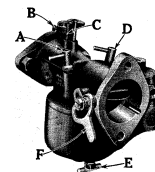

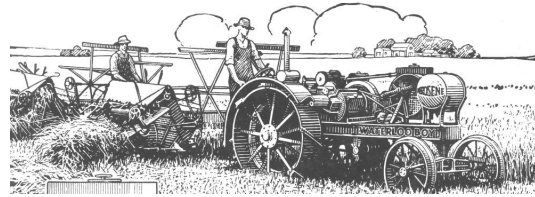
