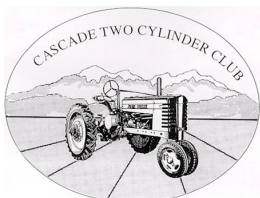

Retrieval of a 1953 John Deere "B"

My son, Mike, who lives in Star, Idaho recently called to let me know that he had found a John Deere B advertised for sale in Cascade, Idaho. The event had three interesting aspects to it: It included three generations, a unique loading procedure and a much anticipated unloading procedure. I drove from Arlington, where I live, to Eastern WA. and picked up my tandem axle trailer and proceeded to Star, Idaho. The next day with my son Mike and grandson Jackson, we set out for Cascade, Idaho. Upon arrival, I was faced with a tractor that would not fit between the fenders on my trailer. After removing one tire and with about a half an hour struggle to move the tire in, I agreed to what the rancher wanted to do in the first place. He swung his Cat track hoe around and I hooked up the chains around the rear axle housings. With skill, which you seldom see, he proceeded to lift the back end up with the front wheel still on the ground and positioned the tractor on backwards with the rear tires in front of the fenders. Just over half of the rear tires were on the trailer, but sufficient to chain it down and hit the road.



We were on the road a full day due to the county closing the road we came on.

We arrived back in Star at the end of a long day.

I stayed another day to rest up and then left for home. I had plenty of time on the trip back to ponder the last component of this event. "How am I going to get this thing off?" After I arrived back in Eastern WA, I positioned the loader bucket of my backhoe beside the trailer and using almost the same chain arrangement, I picked the back wheels up and slowly drove the trailer out from under it. Oh! What a relief it was!

To me, a road trip with family, meeting interesting people with different ideas than my own, and to have a successful ending is a win. Who knows, the tractor may work out well too.

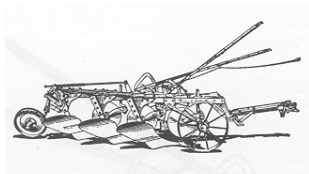

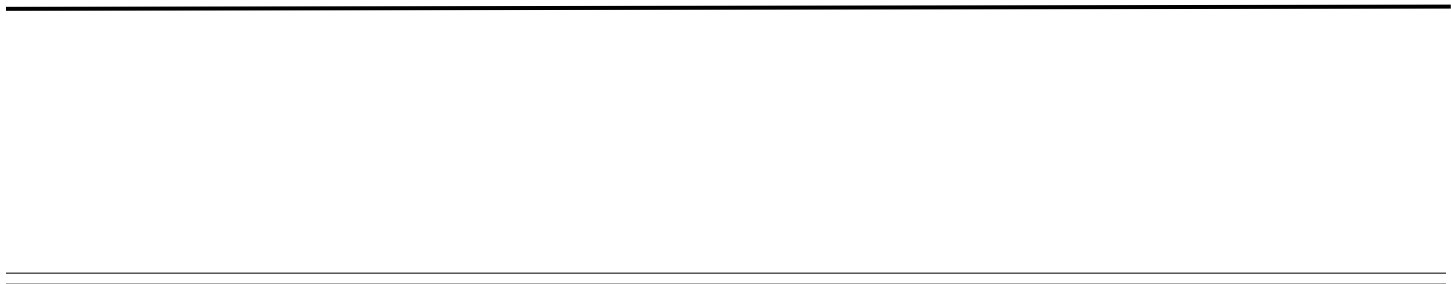
