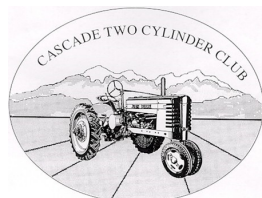

28 Years of Green and Yellow tractor fun

Jim Grove -Long Time Lover of Deere's

Jim got his start with John Deere during high school when he worked for a man that farmed with a JD 4020 and a JD 1020. These tractors were built well and were fun to operate. About 15 years ago, Jim saw a well-used John Deere 2440 with a scraper at Farmers' Equipment. This tractor had spent its life scraping a lot of cow manure at a local dairy farm. It needed some tender loving care and Jim was ready to provide this. Thus began Jim's collection of the green machines.

Jim has an ample machine shop and paint spray booth that makes bringing the tractors back to life easier.

Jim learned to drive a John Deere LA when he was 5 years old, so naturally he needed to find one of those. The 1946 LA was found in Sunnyside, in the Yakima Valley. This tractor was in tough shape and needed a lot of work. The engine was a special challenge to repair. This tractor belongs to his son, C.J. Grove. Jim and C.J. worked together to restore this tractor. Jim drove the JD LA in the 2019 Berry Dairy Days parade in Burlington. Jim purchased a new John Deere 401D backhoe in 1981. It was a very useful, practical machine used in his electrical contracting business for many years.

Another practical Deere is his JD 350 Crawler/bulldozer. It was sold new by Smith Tractor in Tacoma to a contractor. The owner and the JD 350 had a long and productive life together. It ended when the owner had a

heart attack, and the tractor had a blown engine. Jim made the necessary overhaul and brought the crawler back to life. A JD AW and a JD 3010 belonged to a friend who owned a ranch in Eastern Oregon. The friend was getting on in years and decided he wasn't going to restore the tractors himself. He gave them to Jim. Jim did a good job restoring both tractors. You will likely see them this year at some of the events. Jim hopes to have the previous owner drive one in a local parade.

Jim bought a used Gator, which was mechanically sound but needed some cosmetic work. After purchasing new seats, tires, fenders and applying paint, the Gator was ready to work.

The oldest tractor Jim owns is a 1935 AR, which still works. Jim has plans for it in the future.

Jim's favorite tractor is the JD 2440. It is a versatile, easy to drive diesel tractor. His favorite part of collecting is finding them, doing mechanical work, sheet metal repair, painting, field use and displaying them. It is all just so much fun! President's Message

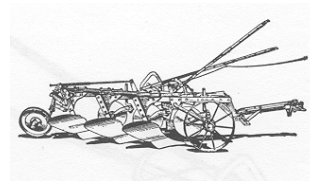

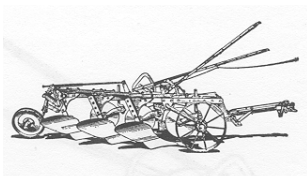
