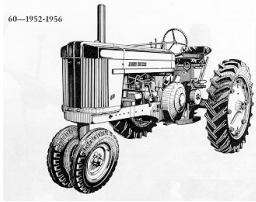

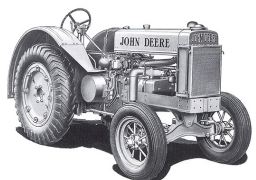

Remembering Jerry

Most people know that Jerry Senner passed away on November 29, 2015 but many don't know what he did for antique equipment collecting in the North Puget Sound area.

Jerry was instrumental in the forming of the Sky Valley Stock and Antique Tractor club in 1984 and served as president in 1988. In 1993 Jerry gave his experience and wisdom to set up the Cascade Two Cylinder Club. He also served as vice president from 1993 to 1997.

Jerry seemed to prefer classic Deeres and was a regular exhibitor at the Puget Sound Antique Tractor and Machinery show at Lynden and of course the Monroe Sky Valley Stock and Antique Tractor Show. Jerry was a master at finding the rare "stuff" and took a little glee in telling you that he found this rare Deere in your own neighborhood. If you needed parts, Jerry could be counted on to have the parts or knew who would have it. Jerry was not in the hobby to make money and you knew that if he sold you a part that it was a good deal and he was trying to help out the collector.

Jerry felt strongly that the old equipment needed to be operational and could show what job it did in it's day. You could see Jerry's tractors running and doing something at the various shows. Jerry old John Deere stationary baler was a regular at Nels and Oscars' Bellville Threshing Show. Jerry plowed with his 1920 something John Deere D on steel at the annual C2CC plow day. His equipment may not have been

Expo quality but they ran, and told a story.

Jerry's African Deere was one of his many exciting projects. He read in the Green Magazine about a Deere collector who overhauled an early styled B and tag plow to be sent to Africa. These old Deeres were simple and were of value to till the African soil. Jerry contacted the Children of the Nations organization based in Silverdale, Washington and learned of a need to improve the farming technique at an orphanage 10 miles outside of Lilongwe, Malawi. The orphanage farm could feed about 80 kids but there was a need to feed 300. The current farm was tilled by hand and a tractor could really improve the production. Jerry put together a shipment of a JD 420 U, 3 pt. 2-14" plow, KBY 6 foot 3 pt. disk and a #14 John Deere hammer mill for shelling corn. The shipping logistics were worked out and the equipment arrived in Lilongwe several days before Jerry. Thanks to the equipment and a new water well the corn crop improved from one ear per stalk to two and three. Success was sweet and filling!

One of Jerry's dreams was to start a museum showing the area's history of farming, mining, logging and transportation. After years of planning and convincing Jerry got the non profit status in 1996. On September 216, 2007 the Western Heritage Center Museum was opened at the Evergreen State Fair Grounds, Monroe, Washington.

Naturally the exhibits needed to be operational and tell a story. This makes this

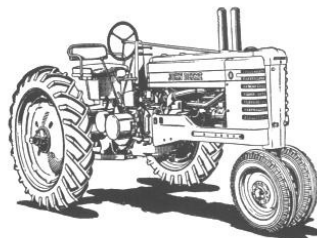
A Farewell to a Tractor Buddy

Let's get out there and support these shows before it's too late! Have you noticed , gas is cheap!

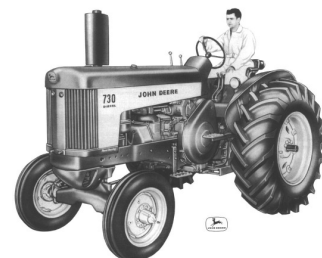
