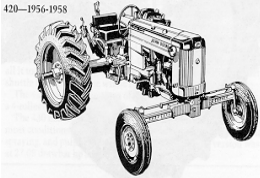

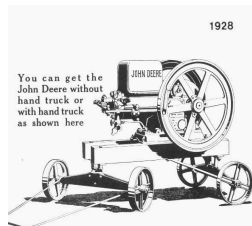

Dick Cleave, Skagit Collector

Dick didn't grow up on a farm or operate a farm like many of the antique tractor collectors. Dick did have a grandfather who was in the Skagit Valley bulb business and owned a Farmall A and later a John Deere 40. His father didn't have a farm but had green houses in south Mount Vernon. He owned Fords. Maybe those agriculture contacts got Dick interested in classic Deeres in retirement.

In Dick's early career, he owned a truck and worked briefly for Home Transfer. This trucking job required Dick to be away from home for up to three months which did not set well with Dick. Dick was able to move on to secure a driving job with Skagit Valley Trucking. 41 years later Dick retired from truck driving. Dick says the people he worked for and with were a real pleasure. Even though Dick drove to all parts of the Western United States and Canada he had great job satisfaction. Most of the product he hauled was finished frozen food products from the Skagit Valley area.

About the time of Dick's retirement, he saw an ad in the Capitol Press for a John Deere 720 diesel with tricycle front end located in Enumclaw. Dick wanted a classic Deere and this tractor was one of the icons of the Deere two cylinder era. The tractor was sold to Dick as a good, solid tractor with recent work done. Haven't we all heard that story before! Dick learned soon that his retirement gift to himself had some major problems... cracked transmission case, broken gears, diesel injector problems, worn out roll o matic etc. Dick contacted Renaissance Tractor and owner Albert Ulrich made the necessary repairs. Dick has done a few additional repairs himself and now has a strong running tractor.

Dick just finished his third Cascade Two

Cylinder Club plow day pulling a 3-16 plow. If you have done any plowing you know that plowing brings out all the problems in a tractor. No problems for this Deere. Joey, Dick's grandson, found the 3-16 3 point plow at the Tellesbo farm on Fir Island. Dick put in some new coulter bearings, new shares and made the plow pretty. Dick says he kind of likes restoring implements and would like to do that in the future. This is a great winter project if you can just get your shop or garage warm!

Dick has been in the club for just a few years but has been active in the plow days and static displays. He plans on getting involved in the various parades this summer. Dick and his grandson Joey attending the Gathering of the Green in 2008 and plans to attend again at the 2010 show in Moline, Illinois.

Dick proudly taught Joey the techniques of commercial truck driving and Joey landed a very good job with Hertz moving rental equipment around the state. A real chip off the old block! Joey really likes his grandfather's JD 720 but prefers the toy collecting avocation. Some day Joey will probably get that special tractor! I hope Joey knows how to plow. 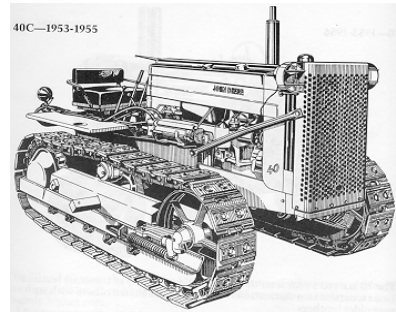

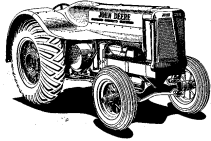
